HOW TO CRACK UPSC EXAM

In today's time, one of the most challenging tasks is to accomplish a competitive exam. Applicants work hard for many years to crack the exam, but only a few succeed. So, it is essential to strategize the studying methodology to succeed in these exams. UPSC is one such prestigious exam. In this article, I will focus upon some of the major strategies to crack the exam.

UNDERSTAND YOUR INTEREST:-

The first requirement is to take a resultant decision after considering all the pros and cons of UPSC services. Some of the major charms of this portfolio are: Respect, Charisma, Connect with society, Opportunity to work with masses at very young age, Job diversity, Job security, Work at grassroot level. Whereas, Frequent transfers, Political interventions, Unstable family life, Stress of Facing media, judiciary, civil society organisations, citizens at large are some of the major challenges to be faced at this post. In short, the reason for you for joining the civil service should be very clear in your mind as it will enable you to sustain motivation during preparation.

HAVE A PLAN - B IN LIFE

It should be clear to you that if you would not be able to clear the civil services, what would you do? This is not to demotivate you, but to help you make a realistic assessment. More than 10 lakh applicants fill the form each year for Prelims, however, only a few 100's get selected. So when you are investing 2-3 prime years of youth, with all energy and resources, it should be clear to you that if you don't qualify, then what else is the career opportunity. Best Time to Start UPSC Preparation

First of all, get a clear idea about eligibility criteria, age, no. of attempts, etc. Some aspirants are clear during school days that they want to join civil services. They can brush up NCERT's & also develop basic understanding of issues relating to society by reading newspapers, magazines and focus on general studies. In addition to above, one can also choose the optional & see the basic topics in that subject. If it is the same as graduation, then no problem. But if it's different from graduation, then knowledge on a subject equivalent to graduation at least is required. So start with basic. Try to make a schedule in which you are able to devote a few hours daily/weekly to Civils preparation.

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



March 2020 will always be remembered with a sigh in the history. The lockdown due to pandemic left a devastating impact on the education system. Lockdown changed the perspective of school and e-learning came to the forefront. However while online pedagogy does a great job of supplementing offline education, it does not serve as a replacement to the latter. The two biggest challenges were encountered in imparting education during corona period. The most underlining obstacle was that a significant percentage of students do not have the same access to digital facilities. Also the online classes or the digital medium hurdles the interpersonal interactions that the schools facilitate by bringing together children from different backgrounds together. The e-content is mostly available in english medium resultantly the students studying in other mediums remain in loss as they are confined to limited e-material. Also the reopening of schools with staggered and rotational rosters , keeping with social — distancing norms only a number of students physically present in the class rooms while arranging and attending the remaining strength of class on live chat, is not a perfect solution but another challenge which the educators have to encounter. Undoubtedly the situations are improving, but we are still at the sea, with our safety nets on, hoping for the wind to get over soon.



Shifting paradigms to align with the ever evolving needs of the dynamic learner, it becomes imperative to transform the system from a conservative and time tested one to an all-inclusive and innovative one. As educators and frontrunners in the field of education, it becomes vital to imbibe the essence of National Education Policy 2020 which is the first education policy of the 21st century and proposes the revision and revamping of all aspects of the education structure, including its regulation and governance so as to make education more experiential, holistic, integrated, inquiry-driven, discovery-oriented, learnercentered, discussion based, flexible and, of course, enjoyable. Before we implement the same as per the directives of the Government, as stakeholders, it is unequivocally crucial for us to understand the key pointers of the policy:

Curriculum and Pedagogy in Schools

- The curricular and pedagogical structure of school education will be reconfigured to make it responsive and relevant to the developmental needs and interests of learners at different stages of their development, corresponding to the age ranges of 3-8, 8-11, 11-14, and 14-18 years, respectively.
- The curricular and pedagogical structure and the curricular framework for school education will therefore be guided by a 5+3+3+4 design.
- It will consist of the Foundational Stage (in two parts, that is,3 years of Anganwadi/pre-school + 2 years in primary school in Grades 1-2; both together covering ages 3-8), Preparatory Stage Grades 3-5, covering ages 8-11), Middle Stage (Grades 6-8, covering ages 11-14), and Secondary Stage (Grades 9-12 in two phases, i.e., 9 and 10 in the first and 11 and 12 in the second, covering ages 14-18).

Key Focus Areas

- Socio-Economically Disadvantaged Groups (SEDGs) SEDGs can be broadly categorized on: ➤ Gender Identities ➤ Socio Cultural Identities ➤ Geographical Identities Disabilities Socio Economic Conditions
- Ensuring Equity This is proposed to be done through ➤ Interventions ➤ Special mechanisms ➤ Ensuring Learning Outcomes ➤ SEZs (Large populations from SEDGs to be declared Special Education Zones ➤ Fee Waivers

How can Schools Prepare?

The NEP 2020 is progressive, practical and very comprehensive. Multi-disciplinary study, interactive classrooms, 21st century skills and flexible assessments are the key highlights of the policy. The specific areas that need addressing are – Changing the pedagogical structure, stress on the importance of literacy and numeracy skills, changes in classroom teaching with the NEP and changes in the assessment pattern. Thus, Administrators, Coordinators and Academic Heads play a crucial role in manifesting the planning and smooth execution of school policies and collaboration amongst various departments. Regular updating of planning skills forms an important part of the learning process.

The Final Word

Any drastic change has its own pros and cons. The trick is to scrutinize the cons and steer a balanced path in order to ensure operative implementation of the novel ideas in a workable environment. As we inch closer to the final stages of the policy, as leaders in education, the onus of acquiescing changes and bracing ourselves for the same lies upon us.

CBSE OASIS full form namely Online Affiliated School Information System is a system/platform created by the Board on their existing website wherein CBSE affiliated schools are required to update certain information.

HOW TO GO FOR OASIS

- 1. Visit the official website of CBSE i.e. cbse.gov.in/
- 2. Four different options will show up on the homepage. Click on 'New Website'.
- 3. Upon reaching the new website, scroll down to search for 'OASIS R-2.0' to get started.
- 4. The user will be required to do a CBSE OASIS login to proceed. They will be required to enter the affiliation number and password provided by CRSE
- 5. After logging in, the user will be able to see two links on the menu, namely 'About Us' and 'OASIS FAQs'.
- 6. Fill the CAPTCHA
- 7. And you will find a long list to be filled.
- 8. Fill it one by one

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
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FUTURE PROOFING SCHOOL LEARNING ECOSYSTEM

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








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
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
